RE: Transmittal No. 13-03 (Decoupling) -- Application of Hawaiian Electric Company, Inc. For Approval to modify the RBA Rate Adjustment in its

Revenue Balancing Account Provision Tariff.

Pursuant to Final Decision and Order and Dissenting Opinion of Leslie H. Kondo, Commissioner, filed on August 31, 2010 filed in Docket No. 2008-0274 ("2008-0274 D&O") by the Public Utilities Commission ("Commission"), the deadline for the Division of Consumer Advocacy of the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs ("Consumer Advocate") to file a Statement of Position ("SOP") is 30 days after the HECO Companies<sup>1</sup> make their Revenue Balancing Account ("RBA") provision filings.

This is to inform the Commission that the Consumer Advocate is continuing to review HECO's RBA provision filing that was filed on March 28, 2013. As part of that review, there are responses to certain information requests that are still outstanding. It is the Consumer Advocate's understanding that HECO should be responding to the outstanding information requests on April 29, 2013. Since HECO's RBA provision tariff was filed on March 28, 2013, pursuant to the 2008-0274 D&O, the Consumer Advocate

should be filing its SOP on April 29, 2013.<sup>2</sup> To allow consideration of the information that HECO will be providing in response to information requests, the Consumer Advocate is seeking additional time to complete its SOP.

As a result, based on the assumption that the outstanding responses will be filed on April 29, 2013, the Consumer Advocate respectfully requests an extension until Monday, May 6, 2013, to file its SOP.
