This is in regards to Young Brothers (YB) changes in shipping of livestock. The changes are prohibitive of people being able to afford to send their horses and other livestock interisland. Please do not grant YB permission to omit LCL freight, and livestock in containers that are not 20" and 40" We need to be able to ship the containers and box stalls that we already have approved by them. Also we need to ship our supplies and house hold goods in the LCL (less then container load) containers.

The best solution is to allow for competition. YB is basically a monopoly and it is unjust and threatens the farm/livestock business and culture in the islands. Until such time as there are options, please do not allow YB to get away with this.

Do not grant them their changes. The cost of shipping a horse was around \$500 (Big Island to Oahu) and now would be around \$3k. It is outrageous.
