The latest e-mail about Young Brothers stopping Less than Container Loads unless they get 25 million dollars is scary. We ship weekly to Oahu, two pallets every Tuesday. We have been doing this for 15 years and really depend on them. We also bring in pallets of new boxes from Seattle Box Company on Oahu about once a month. The shipping with YB is an integral part of our business and ripening of our product. I also received an e-mail from Nicole Pfeffer from the Department of Agriculture and I would really appreciate it if you could forward this e-mail to her. I just registered with the PUC to file an "informal complaint". It will take 2 business days to process my registration. It will be too late. Any help would be appreciated. We are a family farm with 4 families directly affected, my son, my daughter, and my youngest son is also starting to farm next door.
