Aloha PUC commissioners,

Green Energy Team produces 12% of Kauai's electric energy from biomass it grows on its own farm. We frequently rely on Young Brother's services to ship materials and supplies in from Oahu.

A lot of our critical parts and supplies is shipped in through Young Brothers and most of these aren't accepted by airlines: chemicals, fertilizers, heavy parts like steam valves, tires, ag equipment etc. All these are LTL shipments.

If Phase 2 would be allowed, it would seriously hurt and at times shut down our business and our energy production on Kauai.
